Six practice routes in order, every lesson inside them, and the quiz that grades each route. Print it, tick it off, and you have run the whole curriculum.

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Run it in order the first time through

1. Work one route at a time. Read the lesson, run the session, then the drills.
2. Take the route quiz last. Three of four correct certifies the route.
3. Tick the Done column here; if you are signed in on the site, the same steps track automatically.
4. Do not move on because a route feels familiar — move on when you have hit its pass mark.
5. Second pass: pick the two routes whose pass marks you scraped, and repeat only those.
